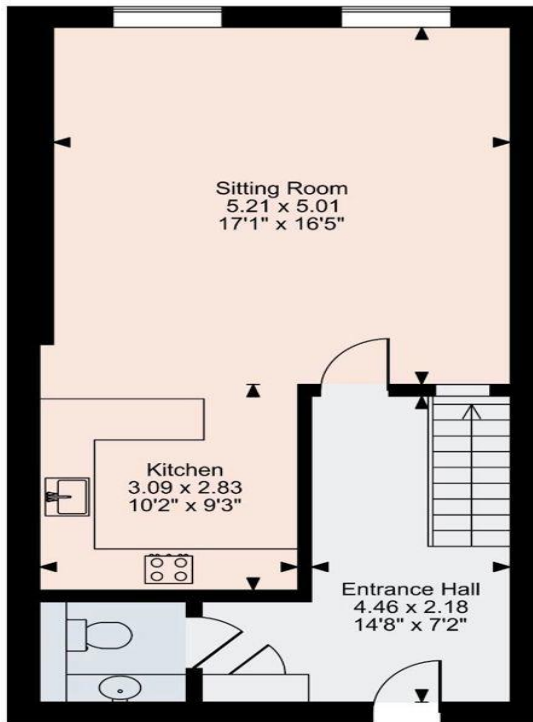

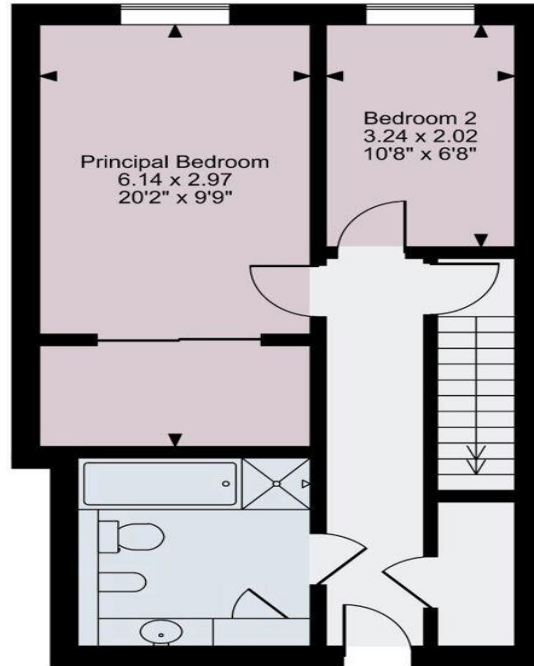

Ground Floor

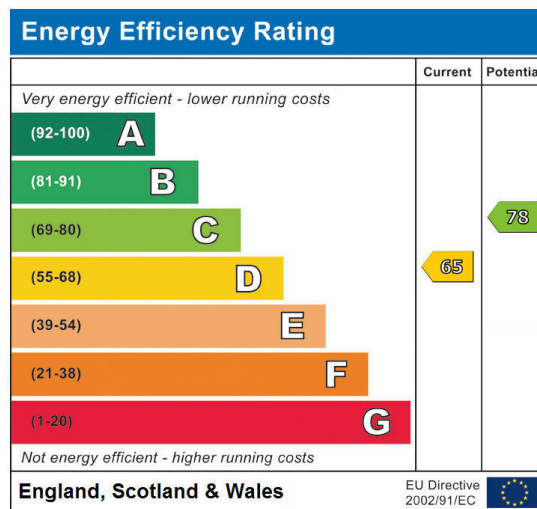


First Floor
